A Message From The Principal's Desk



Dear Williams Township Elementary School Families,

Can everybody agree that we hope winter has stopped showing its ugly face? We all know this school year has been a challenge due to all of the extreme winter weather. Here at Williams Township Elementary School we are moving forward. Every day we are here, we are focused and working hard. Students and staff arrive "ready to roll" and catch up on all the time and instruction we have lost. I am sure with the dedication of our faculty and staff, we will be ready for state assessments and also to complete necessary instruction per grade-level.

The PA System of School Assessment Math & Reading Tests will be administered to students in Grades 3 & 4 during the weeks of April 13th through April 23rd. The PA System of School Assessment Science Test will be administered to students in Grade 4 during the week of April 27th. In order for students to do their best, they will need plenty of rest, a good breakfast each morning, and a happy send off to school. Good attendance ensures that they can take the tests under optimal conditions along with their classmates.

Information has been sent home about the changes in our district calendar due to snow days. In case you are not aware the changes are as follows:

We have used nine (9) snow days this school year. As a result, our school calendar has been amended to include the following changes:

- Monday, March 30, 2015, and Tuesday, March 31, 2015 will now be scheduled school days. All students are to report to school on these days.
- The last student day is scheduled for Friday, June 12, 2015.
- ♦ The end of the third marking period is Tuesday, March 31, 2015. We will still have the scheduled Early Dismissal for Conferences on Friday, March 27th. Students in AM-Kindergarten and Grades 1-4 will be dismissed at 11:55 a.m., and students in PM-Kindergarten will begin at 12:20 p.m. and dismiss at 3:15 p.m.
- The end of the fourth marking period is Friday, June 12, 2015.
- If the District has an additional snow day, Wednesday, April 1, 2015, will become a scheduled school day. If a second snow day becomes necessary, Monday, April 6, 2015, will be scheduled as a school day.

The amended calendar is posted on the District website at www.wilsonareasd.org.

As we move into spring please be sure students are dressed appropriately to go outside for recess. Hopefully, the outside area begins to dry up so students can enjoy the outdoors during the school day. There are many opportunities students are presented with everyday at Williams and they all enjoy participating, not only in their regular classroom, but also during art, music, physical education, and library. Our goal is to help create well rounded children that enjoy learning.

Creating well rounded children is also a goal of our PTA. I want to thank them for continuing to create additional learning opportunities for our students through their funding of programs and the great enrichment courses being offered throughout the year. As always they have done a fantastic job, thank you!

Spring will be here before you know it and with it brings a new beginning and additional motivation for all of us to grow. I want to thank the students, staff, and especially the families of Williams Township for helping create a strong positive environment for the development of children. I feel blessed to serve at Williams and look forward to our continued progress here on the hill.
