### A MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK: Everybody knows that...

Everybody knows that this school year has been a challenge due to all of the extreme winter weather. Here at Williams Township Elementary School we are moving forward. Every day we are here, students and staff are focused and working hard. Many of you are aware that we have the Pennsylvania State Assessments for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade coming up at the end of March. The state has allowed us to push the start of the testing back one week. We will start with math and reading assessments on March 25<sup>th</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> grade science testing at the end of April.

Students and staff have been putting in a good effort, but in order to help with motivation, I have issued the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade a challenge. If 90% of all students are able to pass the math and reading assessments at each grade level, I will come to the second day of school next year dressed as a Ram. I will also visit our current 4<sup>th</sup> grade students at the Intermediate School so they will be able to see me as a Ram. The students are excited about this possibility, but it will be up to them and their performance. Hopefully, they will show what a great job they do every day and I will have to deliver on my end of the bargain. GO RAMS!

The staff has also developed a program to reinforce positive behaviors here at Williams Township Elementary School. Students are asked to follow the Rams Rules which are; **R**espect yourself and others, **A**lways try your best, **M**anners matter, and **S**uccess begins with self-control. Students can be recognized by their classroom teacher for following the Rams Rules or for effort or behavior above the norm. Teachers may recognize students that have turned negative behaviors into positives. This teacher recognition is called "Earning Your Horns." Students that "Earn Their Horns" are recognized on our television broadcast by the principal.

The students that "Earn Their Horns" are eligible to be the grade level Ram of the Month. Students that are selected to be Ram of the Month have their picture taken as a RAM, receive a letter from the principal, and are recognized on the morning broadcast. Be sure to check out the pictures of our Rams of the Month in our lobby trophy case. This program has had a positive impact on our students and allows staff to reinforce great behaviors and effort.

I witness impressive happenings daily at Williams Township Elementary. There have been many additional programs here that have focused on academics, recognition of differences, and charitable achievements for those in need. I would like to thank the PTA for the additional opportunities they have given our students with the plethora of enrichments choices they have offered after school. The PTA programming this year has been greatly enjoyed by our students and staff.

I know we are all tired of Old Man Winter, but we will continue to have school and work hard. Please keep yourself updated of any calendar changes that have occurred due to the amount of snow days. It has been an interesting and fun year so far, and I look forward to the rest of the year with the great students, staff, and families of Williams Township.
