ever, please log into the program and be sure that your number is





The insurance is designed to help supplement any insurance parents may have, by satisfying deductibles or co-insurance requirements, or limiting the possible financial impact of an injury if a parent has no other insurance. The cost of the coverage ranges from \$36 to \$125 annually and provides coverage to children during school hours. 
